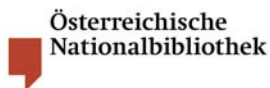

Evaluation & Awards

- Originality
 - Usability
 - Performance
 - Useful for uptake by Europeana, promotes the Europeana API
 - Meets topic: Semantic Web, Linked Open Data or Multilinguality.
- **5 points:** Exceeds one or more of the evaluation criteria in an innovative way
 - **4 points:** Moderately exceeds one or more evaluation criteria.
 - **3 points:** Meets one or more evaluation criteria.
 - **2 points:** Nearly meets at least one evaluation criteria.
 - **1 point:** Doesn't meet any evaluation criteria, but gets a point for participating.
